# Boatbuilding Competition

## RULES FOR QUICK & DIRTY BOATBUILDING COMPETITION

Teams will consist of 2 or 3 people (no one-man teams/boats will be permitted). Two or three companies or organizations may join together to make one team. Each team must consist of employees or members from the company or organization it represents.

**Date: Saturday, September 7, 2013**

**Location: Fishermen's Terminal**

**Entry Fee: \$50 per team entry fee**

The competition will be open to a limited number of teams on a first-come first-served basis. Teams must sign up by August 23, 2013.

Each team may bring as much material to build a boat as they like, with a \$100 (before sales tax) limit. No scrap or donated materials may be used. All material must be purchased, but may be secondhand (bought at garage sales, thrift stores, etc.). Teams must supply receipts for all materials. No sheet or board foam may be used in any part of the boats. Spray foam may be used for sealing and gluing purposes. Partially-complete boats will not be allowed as source materials, even if the purchase price is within the \$100 limit. In addition, teams may bring a company flag/logo to display on the completed boat.

All materials must be as bought at the start of construction. No pre-marking, cutting, etc. will be allowed.

Each team will be provided with a 10'x 20' canopy, which will define the building area. All construction, materials, trash, and tools must be kept within each team's building area.

Teams must bring their own tools to build the boats, including all relevant safety equipment. Eye protection must be worn at all times when using tools that produce flying dust or debris. There is no limitation on the number and type of tools allowed. However, electrical power available will be limited to two or three outlets for each building team. No power besides 110v

AC will be available, and teams will be restricted to 15 amps total power usage. Teams may bring any size paper plans, including full-size templates. Wood or metal templates are not allowed.

Team Captain meeting will be held at 8:45 am, and building will start at 9:00 am. At 3:00 pm, building must stop, and boats will be presented to the judges. Racing will begin at 4:00 pm in the Fishermen's Terminal Marina. (If needed, non-team members may assist in carrying boats to race area.)

Boats must be solely human-powered. All team members must be in their boat during the race. Oars, paddles, etc. must be included in the limit on materials.

Each boat will race on a predefined course in the Fishermen's Terminal Marina. Boats will be raced in heats of no more than three boats each, with the winner of each heat racing in a final heat. Placement in the heats will be by random drawing. Teams are expected to show good sportsmanship during the races, and may not deliberately impede other teams. PFDs must be worn during the races. Team members are encouraged to provide their own PFDs.

### Three trophies will be awarded:

- The Marty Johnson Memorial Quickest Boat Trophy to the winner of the race
  - The "Dirtiest Boat" Trophy to the boat the best exemplifies the spirit of the Quick & Dirty Competition in the opinion of the judges.
  - An award for the best student team
- Any boat that sinks or swamps during the races will be disqualified from a trophy award.

**RELEASE OF LIABILITY**

**(Must be read and signed by ALL participants)**

The PARTICIPANT agrees that the Port of Seattle, its commissioners, officers, agents and employees (hereafter, collectively, the "Port"), Pacific Maritime Magazine, Philips Publishing, the City of Seattle, and all members of Fishermen's Fall Festival (thereafter the "Festival") shall not be liable for any injury (including death) to any persons, including PARTICIPANT, or damage to any property sustained, or alleged to have been sustained, as result of or connection with the Seattle Maritime Festival Quick and Dirty Boatbuilding Contest.

The PARTICIPANT shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Port and the Festival from any and all claims, actions, losses and damages to persons or property (including but not limited to attorneys fees and expenses) suffered as a consequence of or arising or resulting, directly or indirectly, from any act or omission of the PARTICIPANT, including PARTICIPANTS' employees, agents, contractors, or subcontractors on or about the premises. In the event that any lawsuit based upon any such claims, actions, loss, damage or cost is brought against the Port and the Festival, the PARTICIPANT after being notified that such lawsuit has been started, shall defend such lawsuit at no expense to the Port and the Festival; and if, in such lawsuit, a final judgment is rendered against the Port or the Festival, or against the Port or the Festival and the PARTICIPANT jointly, the PARTICIPANT shall promptly satisfy such judgment. Nothing shall require the PARTICIPANT to indemnify the Port against the sole negligence of any Port officers, employees or agents acting within the scope of such person's employment.

The PARTICIPANT shall be liable to the Port of Seattle for any loss, injury, or damage to the Port of Seattle caused by the PARTICIPANT, all persons directly or indirectly employed by the PARTICIPANT, his/her contractors, or subcontractors, or suppliers, in connection with or as a result of the above described Quick and Dirty Boatbuilding Contest.
